



CEO Mason Wins Best Executive (Nonprofit) Women in Business Award

CEO Elisabeth Mason was named the 2011 co-winner of the Best Executive of a Nonprofit or Government Organization (up to 100 employees category), in the 8th annual Stevie Awards for Women in Business. The awards were announced in November 2011 at a gala reception and dinner in New York City.

This prestigious award honors the country's highest-achieving female leaders in the private, public and not-for-profit sectors. Award winners were selected based on their strategic vision and leadership, commitment to their communities and the financial performance of their organizations. The Stevie Awards for Women in Business are the only global, all-encompassing business awards program for women executives, women entrepreneurs, and the organizations they run.
